JOB DESCRIPTION

A few current needs are creating online marketplaces for each company to sell merchandise, development templates and systems for content creation on various social medias, and managing various administrative tasks such as payroll, scheduling, and communications.

Expectations:

Apprenticeship candidates should be self motivated and willing to learn. In addition, you must be good communicators and collaborators and ready and willing to work with others. Comfortable asking questions, asking for help and receptive to feedback from different perspectives. Apprentices should display healthy workplace characteristics such as attending to all commitments on time and communicating with the lead and team ahead of time if a commitment is going to be missed.
